

## AYSO Region 285 Referee Points Policy 2009

In order to get enough referees to cover our region's games, we have adopted a Referee Point System.

In order to qualify for post-season play, teams must earn 10 referee points by having an adult certified referee or a certified junior referee 16 years of age or older work games.

The Region will strictly enforce this policy. No trading or sharing of points will be allowed. Each volunteer referee will commit their points to ONE team and do so by September 12<sup>th</sup>.  
EXCEPTION: A parent with more than one child playing in the league may elect to distribute the points they earn to each child's team however they desire.

POINTS will be awarded as follows:

1. Existing Regional Badge Referees may earn 10 points by attending and passing the test for Intermediate Badge Certification. Existing Intermediate Badge Referees may earn 10 points by attending and passing the test for Advanced Badge Certification.
2. NEW REFEREE RECRUITS 16 years old or older who take the Regional Referee Class and PASS the test to become AYSO REGIONAL REFEREES will receive 5 points
3. EXISTING AYSO REFEREES 16 years old or older earn 5 points for attending REFRESHER TRAINING courses.
4. Center Referees: Earn 1 point for games in U8-U12. Earn 2 points for games in U14 and above.
5. Assistant Referees: Earn 1 point for games U10 and above (U8 games do not necessarily use AR's).
